AAKF TECHNICAL QUALIFICATIONS GUIDE FOR

COACH CERTIFICATION

I. GENERAL

To be officially qualified to coach in an official event, an individual must have an AAKF Certified Coach's license; also, an AAKF Ranking Examiner must have an AAKF Certified Coach's license.

II. QUALIFICATIONS OF CERTIFIED COACH

- A. Hold proper rank as shown in Section III below (Classes of Certified Coaches & Requirement Chart).
- B. Have completed an AAKF Certified Coaches Course and successfully taken the Certified Coaches examination.
- C. Hold certification in CPR, or verified equivalent level of ability by the respective country.
- D. Have participated in and competed an AAKF sanctioned Judges Seminar & hold Judges Ranking as shown in Section III below (Classes of Certified Coaches & Requirement Chart).
- E. Submit recommendation from respective Regional Director.

IV. REGISTRATION

A. Registration

Through the respective AAKF Regional Office, send the following documents and fees to the AAKF National Office:

- 1. Completed AAKF Certified Coaches Registration Form.
- 2. Copy of certification of passing AAKF Certified Coaches Examination.
- 3. Copy of certification of successful completion of AAKF sanctioned Judges Seminar.
- 4. Copy of CPR certification within respective states.
- 5. Registration fees, as decided by the AAKF Board of Directors.

B. Diploma

The AAKF National Office will issue the appropriate diploma.

V. TERMS OF RENEWAL

- A. The term of a Certified Coach is two calendar years or less, beginning from initial date of registration to the end of the following year.
- B. For renewal before the end of the term, the individual must send the following documents and fees to the AAKF National Office through their respective Regional Office:
 - 1. Completed AAKF Certified Coaches Renewal Application Form.

- 2. Copy of certification of completion of AAKF sanctioned Judges Seminar or Judges Refresher Course.
- 3. Verification of completion of any Technical requirements as determined by the AAKF Technical Committee.
- 4. Renewal fees, as decided by the AAKF Board of Directors.

Remark:

Three (3) months after the end of a term, new registration is required and the candidate must complete a new registration procedure as outlined in Section III (Chart for the Expired Class).
