AAKF TECHNICAL QUALIFICATIONS GUIDE FOR

RANKING EXAMINER CERTIFICATION

I. GENERAL

For ranking to be recognized by the AAKF, the examination must be conducted by an examiner registered with AAKF.

II. QUALIFICATIONS OF RANKING EXAMINER

Qualifications are awarded under the following authority:

Level 1-7

Examiner qualifications are issued under the direct authority of the AAKF upon completion of the qualification process.

III. CLASSES OF REGISTERED EXAMINERS

Registered Examiners include classes 1-7. The authority of each class is as follows:

Class 1:	Examiner can conduct up to and including 6 th (Green) Kyu exam.						
Class 2:	Examiner can conduct up to and including 3 rd (Brown) Kyu exam.						
Class 3:	Examiner can conduct up to and including 1 st Kyu exam.						
Class 4:	Examiner can conduct up to and including a Sho-Dan exam; two can						
	conduct a Ni-Dan exam.						
Class 5	Examiner can conduct up to and including Ni-Dan exam; two can conduct						
	a San-Dan exam.						
Class 6	Examiner can conduct up to and including San-Dan exam; two can						
	conduct a Yon-Dan.						
Class 7	Examiner can conduct up to and including Yon-Dan exam; three can						
	conduct a Go-Dan.						

Remarks: Classes 1, 2, 3

- 1) Examiner can only conduct an exam within his/her own respective region.
- 2) Each examiner is limited to testing within his/her own respective style. (For further details see AAKF Ranking Standard Table)

IV. QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTERED EXAMINER

A. Registered AAKF Certified Coaches as per Classes 1-7

B. Registered AAKF Certified Judge: Kata and Kumite Judges Certification as Classes 1-7

C. Registered Rank with AAKF

- 1. Class 1: Sho-Dan or higher
- 2. Class 2: Ni-Dan or higher
- 3. Class 3: San-Dan or higher
- 4. Class 4: Yon-Dan or higher
- 5. Class 5: Go-Dan or higher
- 6. Class 6: Roku-Dan or higher
- 7. Class 7: Sitchi-Dan or higher
- D. Any other requirements as stated by AAKF Ranking Examiner Standards (See AAKF Coach, Judge and Examiner's Requirement Charts)

V. REGISTERED RANKING EXAMINERS

A. Registration

The following documents are to be sent to the AAKF Office through the respective AAKF Regional Office.

- 1. Completed Examiner Registration Form signed by both applicant and Regional Director.
- 2. Copy of the AAKF Certified Coach Diploma.
- 3. Copy of AAKF Certified Judge Diploma for both Kata and Kumite.
- 4. Registration fees, as decided by the AAKF Board of Directors

VI. TERMS OF RENEWAL

A. The term of a registered examiner is for a period of two calendar years or less beginning from initial date of registration to the end of the following year.

B. Renewal Procedure

To qualify for renewal, the following documents and fees are to be sent through the respective Regional Office to AAKF Office.

1. Completed AAKF Ranking Examiner Renewal Application Form.

- 2. Renewal fees, as decided by the AAKF Board of Directors.
- 3. Completion of any Technical Requirements as outlined by the AAKF Technical Committee.

Remarks:

- 1) Three (3) months after the end of a term, new registration is required as per Section VIII Chart for the expired class.
- 2) Upon renewal, the AAKF will issue a diploma.

VII. REGISTRATION TO A HIGHER CLASS

In the case of an examiner attaining the next higher class, registration procedures must be followed as outlined in Section V. If any portion of the former class rating term still remains upon reaching the higher class rating, there is no refund of fees.

<u>0 (White) through 6th Kyu (Green)</u>: One Class 1 (or higher) Examiner

<u>3rd Ky (Brown)</u>: One Class 2 Examiner

1st Kyu: One Class 3 (or higher) Examiner *OR*

Two Class 2 Examiners

Sho-Dan: One Class 4 (or higher) Examiner *OR*

Two Class 3 Examiners

Ni-Dan: One Class 5 (or higher) Examiner *OR*

Two Class 4 Examiners

San-Dan: One Class 6 (or higher) Examiner *OR*

Two Class 5 Examiners OR

One Class 5 & Two Class 4 Examiners

(And approval of AAKF Technical Committee)

Yon-Dan: One Class 7 Examiner *OR*

Two Class 6 Examiners OR

One Class 6 Examiner & Two Class 5 Examiners OR

Four Class 5 Examiners

(And approval of AAKF Technical Committee)

Go-Dan: Two Class 7 Examiners *OR*

One Class 7 & Two Class 6 Examiners OR

Four Class 6 Examiners

(And approval of AAKF Technical Committee)

Roku-Dan: Three Class 7 Examiners *OR*

Two Class 7 & Two Class 6 Examiners *OR* One Class 7 & Four Class 6 Examiners
