ITALIAN CIRCUIT	R\$ 300,00 per person	<p>The tour to the region of Colombo (PR) allows you to discover the legacy left by the Italian colonization, which is present in the customs, religion, typical food, architecture and folklore. Going through the parks, farm hotels, small farms (optional horseback ride) and historic churches, one can also taste the cheeses, salamis and wine production of Italian settlers in canteens, which are available for purchase, and also get to know the main attraction of the tour, the Municipal Park Cave Bacaetava.</p> <p>Included: Transport, lunch and local guide. HISTORICAL LAPA	R\$ 209,00 per person	<p>Lapa is a city in the interior of Parana which shows its history around every corner and in every monument built to its heroes. In town, there is a visit to the Cave of the Monk and you can pass by old houses and homes of army officers who fought in the Federalist War. ITAJAI VALLEY	R\$ 375,00 per person	<p>It leaves for Itajai Valley and it visits the first city in the tour, Joinville, known as the City of Princes. Its predominant culture is German. This small Germany in Brazil, has a significant representation in the state. A strong economy that represents one of the largest income in the state of Santa Catarina. It has traditional festivals that attract public from around the world, as the Joinville Dance Festival and the Oktoberfest. There are interesting visits to museums like the Firefighter Museum or a ride through San Francisco Bay with Prince of Joinville boat. After that, it goes on to Itajai, a city port, with its great concentration of businesses import and export. Balneario Camboriu Beach is famous for its busy nights, with thematic nightclubs, cable car ride and <i>Cristo Luz</i> Monument, which has a privileged view of the city. Blumenau, surrounded by glamour, has a strong German tradition, with its most traditional and world known party. The Oktoberfest has made the city the center of all German festivals in Brazil. It is traditionally known for its knitting and crystal factories too. It is worth getting to know this little Germany inside Brazil.</p> <p><u>Obs.</u> Minimum of 2 people.</p>
